Getting there

Tram 81 — Stop Bethléem, directly in front of La Tricoterie

Métro lines 2, 3, 4, 6 — Stop Porte de Hal, 5 minutes on foot

Train — Brussels-Midi station, 10 minutes on foot or Tram 81

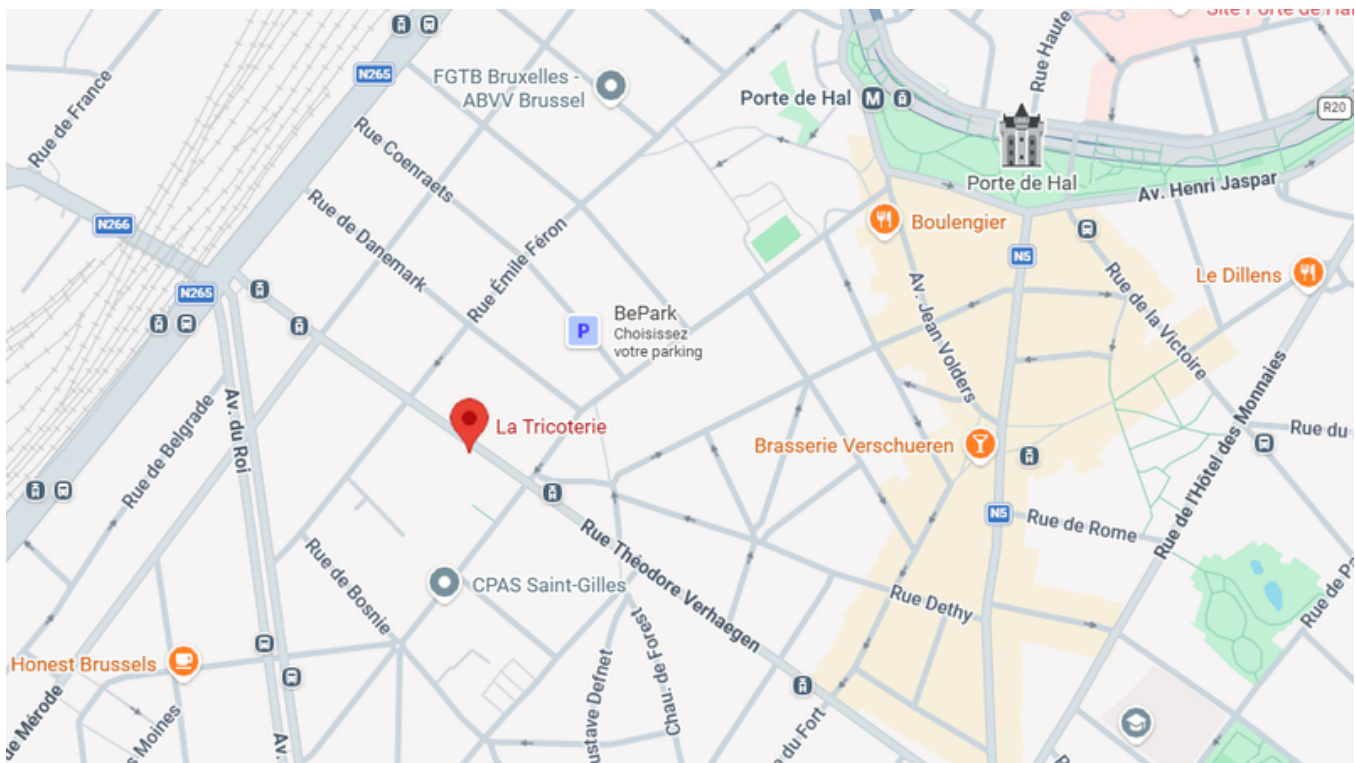
Bus lines 48, 49, 50 — Stop Avenue du Roi, 3 minutes on foot

Bike — Villo station 1 minute away · bike parking in front of the venue

Car — space car park 8 minutes away (shuttles available) - Interparking de la Porte de Hal (near Bordet hospital)

From Brussels-Midi (Eurostar/Thalys/TGV terminal): take Tram 81 direction Erasme, stop Bethléem — 4 stops, under 10 minutes.

From Brussels-Zaventem Airport: take the Airport Express train to Brussels-Midi, then Tram 81.

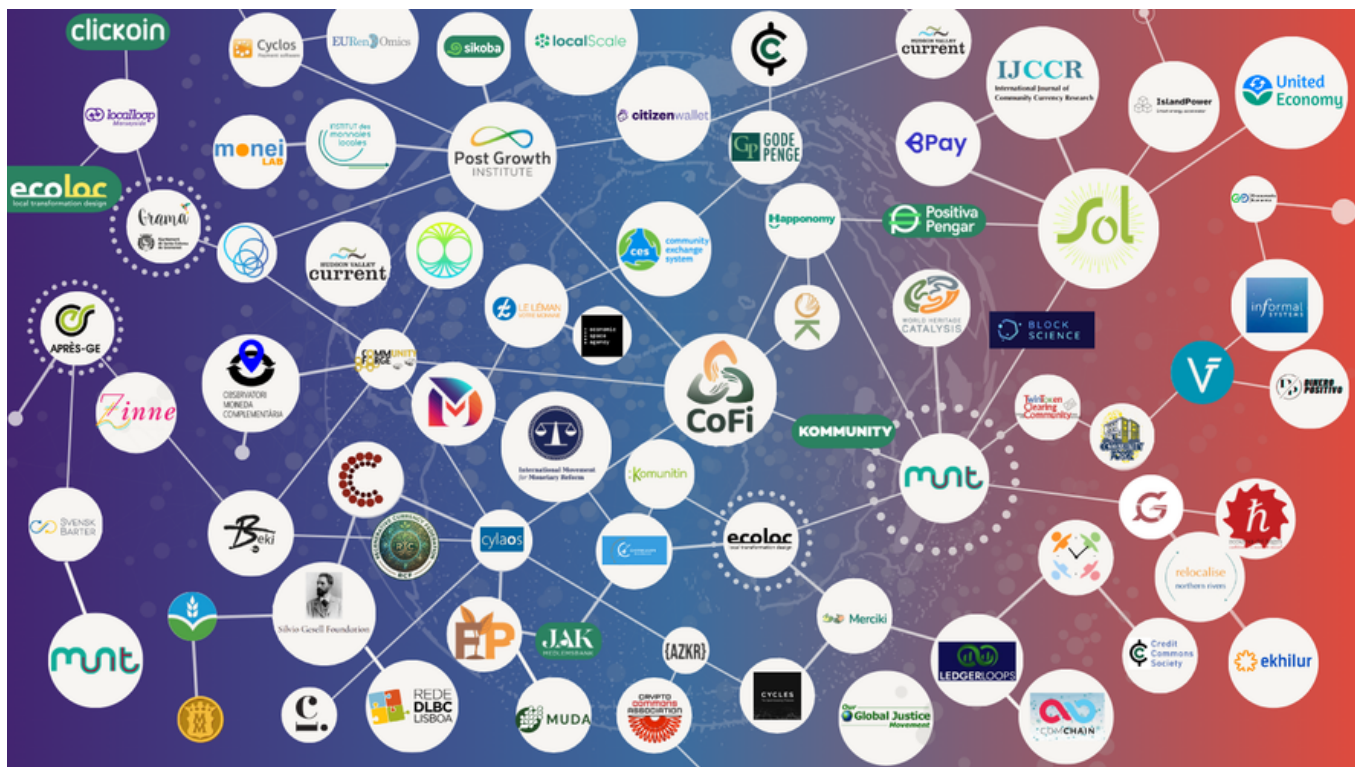
